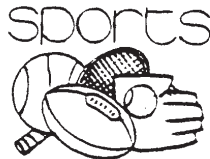
ONE BREAD, ONE BODY

ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION

Fall Sports Sign-ups for next year's grades 4-8 is now open on the St. Cecilia Sports Web Page, <http://www.leaguelineup.com/welcome.asp?url=saintcecilia>. Parents can sign their child up for the following sports: Western Irish Cheerleading, Girls Volleyball, Boys Soccer, and Girls Soccer.

We will also need your help as commissioners and coaches. If we are unable to have enough players to field a team in grades 4-8 sports and you sign your child up, we will do everything we can to find a team with a close parish so they may participate. If there are any questions please see the Athletic Director.

Parents with children in Preschool-Grade 3 can sign up for Western Irish Flag Football and Flag Cheerleading as well. The Flag Football league allows the children to learn some of the basics of football and to meet some of the children from other schools whom they may later play tackle football with. The Flag Football Program consists of two parts: 1) Camp on Wednesday, July 29-Friday, July 31 for 1½ hours a night. Wednesday & Thursday the location will be St. Cecilia; on Friday the camp is at OLPH. 2) League – the league usually starts practicing the week after the camp and runs into October, with teams playing approximately 8 games. Practices are held once or twice a week and games once a week, usually on Saturday mornings. Children can participate in the camp only, the league only, or preferably both. More information will follow by e-mail when the dates, times and prices have been set.
